

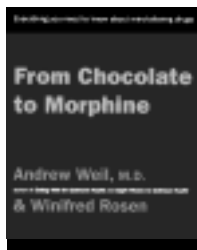

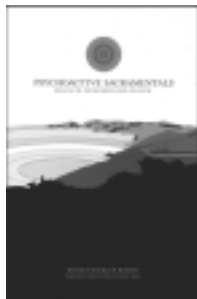
**Why Our Drug Laws Have Failed and What We Can Do About It: A Judicial Indictment of the War on Drugs** by Judge James P. Gray, 2001.

This book thoroughly documents all of the ways in which the drug war hurts society, and concludes with detailed descriptions of several possible alternative approaches.



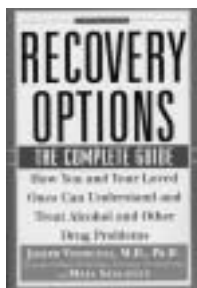

This groundbreaking drug education book is a must-read for young people and their families. Just say "know"!



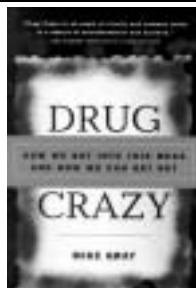
**Psychoactive Sacramentals: Essays on Entheogens and Religion** by Thomas B. Roberts, 2001.

Two UU ministers are included in this thought-provoking collection of essays by the world's leading experts on this fascinating, controversial topic.



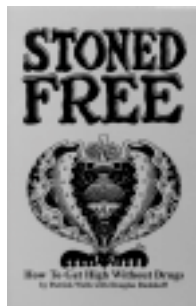
**Recovery Options: The Complete Guide** by Joseph Volpicelli, M.D. and Maia Szalavitz, 2000.

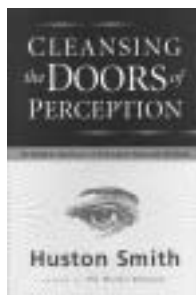
**Drug Crazy: How We Got Into This Mess and How We Can Get Out** by Mike Gray, 1998 (screenplay writer for *China Syndrome*).
